## Unlocking Potential: AIA Women's Leadership Summit 2024

The gender gap in architecture in Minnesota and nationally remains both persistent and concerning. Research shows that the percentages of women studying architecture, becoming licensed, and joining AIA are growing, but women still lag behind men in participation in our profession at all levels.

challenges and fostering a strong sense of community. Equally crucial are systemic changes aimed at identifying and rectifying disparities in pay, enhancing support for licensure pursuits, and minimizing bias within our profession.

## AIA Continuing Education Requirement FAQ

Please note that the following FAQ addresses the AIA CE requirement for AIA members. For licensure requirements visit this <u>website</u>.

## What are the AIA membership requirements for continuing education?

- AIA Architect and International Associate members are required to complete 18 learning units (LUs) of continuing education every year. Of those 18 LUs, at least 12 must be for approved health, safety, and welfare (HSW) courses.
- Architect Emeritus members are required to complete one (1) LU each membership year.
- Associate and Allied members do not have a continuing education requirement.
- New members are not required to complete the AIA continuing education requirement until their first full year as a member. For example, someone who joins in June will not be required to complete 18 LUs until the following year.

### Can I retake the same course for credit?

No, you cannot repeat the same program for credit. Members may repeat a course, but no additional credit will be awarded.

How do I access my AIA transcript? Access your AIA transcript here.

Does AIA have a roll-over policy?

If a member does not meet the annual continuing education requirement but exceeded the requirement the prior year, a limited number of credits may be applied to fill any shortfall. Credits are applied at the end of the following year to address any shortfall and do not appear on the transcript. Only the number of hours needed to meet any deficiency will be applied.

Does AIA Minnesota provide continuing education opportunities?

#### LEADERSHIP FORUM



The morning of the June Leadership Forum featured four design professionals who were invited to share their advocacy stories with a focus on how their values and personal experiences have shaped their advocacy journey. The panel included Elizabeth Turner, AIA (climate advocacy); Sarah St. Louis, Assoc. AIA (disabillty advocacy); James Garrett, Jr., FAIA (community advocacy); and Amy Kalar, AIA (advocacy with AIA Minnesota and equity). The discussion was facilitated by Sheri Hansen, AIA Minnesota director of communications, advocacy and public outreach. Our thanks to each of them for their time and for sharing their

personal stories and experiences.
